

Fellow Alpha Zeta alumni,
Please consider participating in Alpha Zeta's
Trustee Matching Scholarship Program through
Penn State.

Now that the Trustee Scholarship has been
created, the University is providing 10 percent
of the total amount pledged. This means that the
University's funds are available for student awards
now, even before our pledge is fulfilled. For
example, to our \$50,000 pledge, the university
has added \$5,000 to the amount of the scholarship
award. This amount has been granted in the first
year that the scholarship was awarded.

The funds continue every year now, along with a
percentage (currently, about 4.5 percent) of the
endowment's market value. When the endowment
becomes fully funded, a Trustee Scholarship will
provide about 15 percent of the endowment's
market value each year.

We are able to target the scholarship to Alpha
Zeta students, and if none apply, to students in the
College of Agricultural Sciences.

We have received more than \$10,000 toward the
creation of this scholarship. We need to receive
another \$10,000 by June 1, 2015 and then
\$10,000 a year for the next three years.
